Teamwork





PURPOSE

This tool is designed to provide a health check for teams and if there is a problem to help determine what that problem is. It assists people to think through three aspects of teamwork communication, coordination and cooperation. If a 'no' response is recorded for any of the items this should be used as the starting point for a discussion with members of the team. Please note that while this tool is as comprehensive as possible it will not detect all of the ways teams can become impaired.

COORD	INATION	Are the roles and responsibilities of team members clear?	Is everyone adjusting to meet the demands of the situation?
		Are actions always carried out as expected?	Are team members requesting assistance from others, where necessary?
		Does everyone have a common understanding of information relating to the operation?	Are team members correcting any mistakes made by others?
		Is there a clear and common purpose?	
COMMUN	CATION	Is information being passed on in a timely manner?	Are appropriate communication procedures being used?
		Is information being passed on accurately?	Are situation updates being provided?
		Are team members ensuring that information has been received and understood by others?	
COOPI	RATION	Does everyone show a willingness to work as a team?	Are any differences of opinion being resolved effectively?
		Do team members exhibit confidence and trust in each other?	Is anyone creating unnecessary conflict?
		Is everyone following team objectives without opting for independence?
